Suggested Covid 19 Protocol for Kamloops Wine Festival's Wine paired "Bubble" dinner party

In Preparation:

- Just prior to guests arriving at your home all touch surfaces should be sanitized
 - inside the house:
 - in the kitchen, hallway and bathroom, railings, door knobs, etc.
 - o outside:
 - door knobs, railings, gate, drink station, cooler etc.
- Masks and clear face covers may be provided for each guest if they wish to use them. Or, ask guests to bring their own.
- One person should be responsible for pouring the wines. This reduces the amount of people touching an item.
- Wrap sanitized cutlery, while wearing sanitized gloves, in napkins for each place setting.
- Whoever is serving the food should have sanitary gloves and masks on during food service.
- Hand sanitizer should be in a prominent spot, should anyone wish to use it at any time.
- Tables should be set up with 6-foot distancing and set up in such a way that will still be conversational. If you wish to sit closer together with your "bubble" person/people you may do so at your own table. Please keep your groups under 50 people and if possible, do your event outside.
 - If you are having a larger group, any thing over 6, we suggest contacting Interior Display Services for all you will need for your Covid protection. Neil will ensure you have everything you need and have it placed appropriately. intdis@shaw.ca or 250-374-6114. Tell Neil "Judy sent you". He will take good care of you and your guests.
- Water and soda water containers may be placed at each place setting or have the same person serve the water.
- Disinfectant and wipes should be made available in the bathroom. Place a sign in your bathroom with paper towel and disinfectant. Ask them to ensure to wipe down all areas that have been touched while in the bathroom. Paper towels should be placed in the bathroom for drying their hands, with a waste container nearby.

During the event:

- Any items that will be brought by your guests should be wiped down with a sanitizer before lid or saran wrap removed.
- Ask guests to please be respectful of others and maintain a safe distance from all attending the event.
- Ask guests to sanitize their hands before entering the gathering area or home.
- Cutlery and glasses should be removed from tables by one who is wearing gloves and mask. Items should be put directly into the dishwasher.

Ask your guests If they are not feeling well, have any cold or Covid symptoms prior to arriving to please refrain from attending the event – even though they will be missed! Perhaps they can send someone else in their place.

We hope these suggestions will help you. We want to ensure that you can gather together safely and enjoy the evening.
